When The Vertigo Club processes your payment card at the point of purchase, your credit card information is transferred in encrypted form. We DO NOT accept credit card purchases via The Vertigo Club website. **You will NEVER receive emails from The Vertigo Club asking for your credit card number. If you ever receive an email asking for credit card information, DO NOT REPLY TO IT.** Instead, forward it IMMEDIATELY to the Managing Partner at William@TheVertigoClub.com.

How do we ensure security?

We use SSL (Secure Sockets Layer) technology to encrypt your name, address, and credit card number, so that your personal data cannot be accessed while traveling over the Internet.

How to deal with fraudulent charges?
